




Kneisel Hall Children's Concerts In-Person

Finding car seat installation confusing?

We can help! Meet with a nationally certified child passenger safety technician and we will walk you through the proper installation of your children's car seats as well as educate about best practices.



What to expect at a car seat check:

A certified tech will assess your current setup, give information for any adjustments needed, check for recalls, and help you to reinstall your seats securely. They will answer any questions you have on keeping your kids as safe as possible in vehicles. Checks usually take about 30-45 minutes depending on your situation.


